The children will also enjoy outside play and traditional summer activities.

About St. Clement

St. Clement has been serving children in our community since 1952. The school is committed to providing a safe, nurturing environment where young children can learn, grow and develop a life long love of learning.

Beginning at age two and a half, we provide a developmentally appropriate early childhood experience where children thrive. Our daily activities include small motor activities, blocks, outdoor time, music, stories, art, and more!

Age Requirements

Children must be 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ by the start of any session they attend. Children must be toilet trained for pool activities, but toilet training is not required for school admission.

This year in Session I and II, we will offer a class designed for siblings or alums of St. Clement! We will accept children who have completed Kindergarten and first grade. The subject matter will be the same, but at an appropriate developmental level.

What to Bring to Camp

Each child must supply a 6 oz. bottle of sunscreen, SPF 30 or higher. Siblings may not share sunscreen according to state law. Campers should bring their lunch (unless it is a special lunch day); no glass or candy should come to school.
